

Additional Learning Support Policy

When you come to study with Floorskills, we want you to be able to fulfil your potential. We want all our students to develop into self-motivated, independent, lifelong learners and we offer a range of support to help you to achieve this.

Floorskills supportive learning environment is particularly evident in the services we provide through our Additional Learning Support (ALS). This support is available to all our students and covers additional practical training if required, including additional English and Maths support.

Support can be provided for students with:

- Specific learning difficulties
- Physical/sensory impairment
- Medical conditions
- Mental health issues
- Temporary injuries

Additional learner support is identified on application, face to face contact, induction and on completion of initial and diagnostic assessment.

If Floorskills identifies a condition which is likely to affect your personal learning over time we will put in place additional learning days to help the student stay on target with the completion of their apprenticeship.

Floorskills apprenticeships run on block release so we are able to recover and provide additional help and training at multiple points throughout the apprenticeship/training course to suit the students' needs and requirements.

A professional and qualified Functional Skills Tutor is in place to personalise learning needs and the suitable support is put in place to accommodate the individual.
